PAIRS Fences 85cm – 90cm **ORANGE MARKERS**
Class 4 Junior BRC Area 12 Novice Championship
Class 5 Senior BRC Area 12 Novice Championship
BRC Pairs may consist of any Open and Novice combinations. Horses may only compete once in the pairs cross country in addition to a Open/Novice Class.
Class 6 Open to any combination of pairs of horse and rider.

Entry Fee: £20.00 per individuals, £80.00 per team (All team entries must be on one cheque with name of club and team name written on the back. No individual competitor cheques for teams please).

Teams will not be allowed to compete until all fees are paid up in full before the start of the competition.

Please make cheques payable to **BRC AREA 12**. Paramedic fees are included in the entry fees. No late or telephone entries in BRC classes.

Any dishonoured cheques will incur a £10 administration fee.

Late withdrawals: Please inform the Secretary as soon as possible.

Bad Weather: it is the responsibility of the competitors to check with the organiser if the weather is inclement on the day of competition.

COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

1. All classes will be run and judged in accordance with the appropriate Rules 2008 for British Riding Clubs, a copy of which is available at the Secretary's caravan.
2. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are responsible, neither the organisers nor the B.H.S. nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies will accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to any person or property whatsoever. We recommend you take out Personal Accident Insurance.
3. In all cases the Steward's decision is final. Any objection should be accompanied by a deposit of £20 and be lodged within half an hour of the incident, The deposit will be returned only if the objection is held.
4. Correct dress shall be worn. Everyone mounted, whether competitor or not, shall wear a hard hat which is of EN1384, PAS105 or prefixed with ASTM or SEI standard. Such headgear shall be worn properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
5. Back protectors to Beta standard Class 1-3 (green, orange or purple label) are compulsory for all Hunter Trial competitors.
6. A medical armband is compulsory. It is recommended that they be worn on the arm and outside of any clothing.
7. Dogs must be kept on a short lead AT ALL TIMES.
8. The organisers reserve the right, in the light of prevailing circumstances to cancel the event, alter classes, judges, time or any other published information.
9. If the event is cancelled refunds will be at the discretion of the organisers. Paramedic fees will not be refunded
10. Vet fees incurred at the event are the responsibility of the horse rider or owner.
11. The event organisers regret that it will not be possible to refund entry fees if a rider or horse is withdrawn after close of entries
12. The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry for a class if the space does not permit it. No entries will be accepted without the correct entry fee.
13. The whole cross country course will be timed and the competition run under the optimum time rules. Stopwatches, mobile telephones or any other watch will not be allowed.
