

GENERAL CONDITIONS AND RULES – PLEASE READ

By entering this competition, competitors accept the risks involved in horse riding and competing. Save for death or injury caused by the negligence of the landowner or officials of West Somerset Riding Club for which they are legally responsible, the landowners and officials will not accept any liability for any accident, loss, injury or damage to competitors, property, vehicles, animals or spectators of any description.

This event is covered by British Riding Club's insurance but competitors are advised to hold their own personal injury insurance cover.

The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to safeguard the health and safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, competitors and spectators are required to take due care at all times and to obey any notices or requests made by official stewards in the interests of their own and others safety.

Hats to current British Safety Standards must be worn and securely fastened when mounted. Dress code in accordance with BRC rules.

The judge's decision is final. Objections must be made to the Secretary's Office within 15 minutes of the results or incident with a £10 deposit. The deposit will be reimbursed if the objection is upheld.

Please keep dogs on a lead at all times, including around the parking area.

Please remove litter and droppings from the parking area.

Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside lorry/trailer and left unattended or tied up to any fencing.

No lunging allowed in warm up area.

The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule or advertised start time, refuse any entry and cancel any class or competition should conditions be or become unsuitable.

All horses/ponies must be 4 years old and over. No horse can be entered twice in one class.

- Class 1** **BD Introductory Test A (2008)**
Restricted to horse/pony and rider combination who have not been placed 1st in any dressage competition
- Class 2** **Prelim 12 (2005)**
Open to all riders, but will include the Qualifier for WSRDC. Please complete entry form if eligible.
- Class 3** **Prelim 10 (2005) – Open to all riders**
- Class 4** **Novice 27 (2007)**
Open to all riders, but will include the Qualifier for WSRDC. Please complete entry form if eligible.

(Classes 1 & 2 will be on grass. Classes 3 & 4 will be on a surface)

The first two competitors in classes 2 and 4 will qualify for the **Western Somerset Region Dressage Championships** to be held at Stockland Lovell Sunday 10th October 2010. To be eligible, horses in the Prelim class must have no BD points, and those in the Novice class no more than 49 BD points at the time of the qualification. Riders must also be a member of one of the following Area 12 Riding Clubs: Witheridge, Taunton & District, West Somerset, Exeter, Quantock, Sid & Otter Valley, North Devon or Blackdown Hills. The winners of the championships will receive a training grant with the trainer of their choice.
